Addition and subtraction word problem

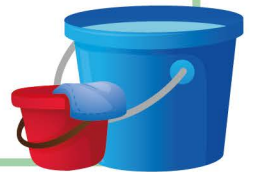
In each case solve and answer in the spaces provided.

- ❖ There are 8 buckets in Mummy Rosie's house. She went to market and bought some 6 more. How many buckets does Mummy Rosie have now ?

- 8 buckets
- 6 buckets

$$\boxed{8} + \boxed{6} = \boxed{14}$$

Mummy Rosie has 14 buckets now.



- ❖ In my junior sister's crib, there are 3 baby dolls, 4 toy-cars and 3 balls. How many toys are there altogether ?



- Baby dolls → 3
- balls → 4
- car-toys → 3

$$3 + 3 + 4 = 6 + 4 = 10$$

There are 10 toys altogether.



- ❖ Mr. Jacob is the director of the most popular school in our city. Yesterday he came to assess the number of pupils present in the first grade class. 19 of them were present. If 8 of them were boys, how many girls were there ?

- 19 pupils
- 8 boys

$$\boxed{19} - \boxed{8} = \boxed{11}$$

There were 11 girls.



- ❖ On the 20th of July, aunty Daisy bought for me a large delicious cake as my birthday present. I then cut it into 17 pieces so as to share with my friends in school. I shared just 13 pieces, then I ate the rest. How many pieces of the cake did I eat ?

- 17 pieces of cake
- 13 pieces of cake

$$\boxed{17} - \boxed{13} = \boxed{4}$$

I ate 4 pieces of cake.
