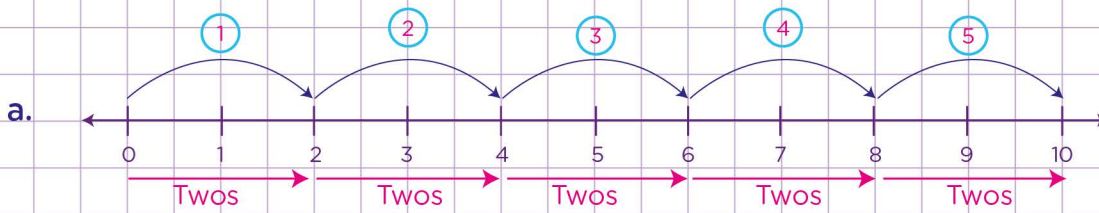

How to write multiplication sentences using number lines

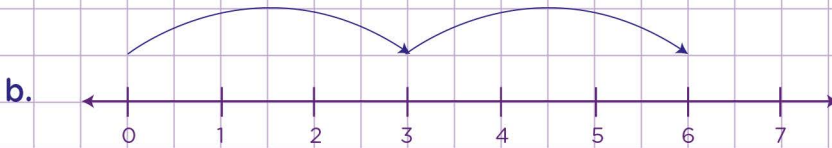
Use the number lines below to write a multiplication sentence.



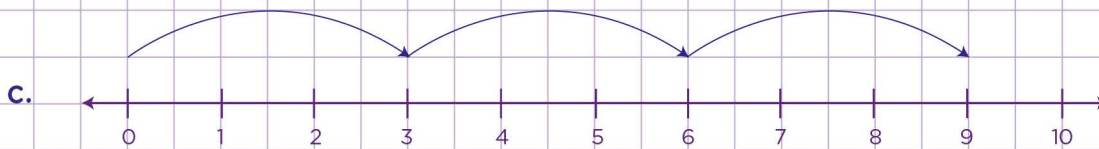
Let's interpret the number line.

You see that, on the number line we skip counted by twos 5 times and ended at 10.

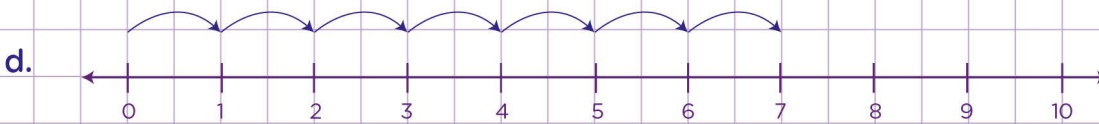
So, the multiplication sentence is $5 \times 2 = 10$.



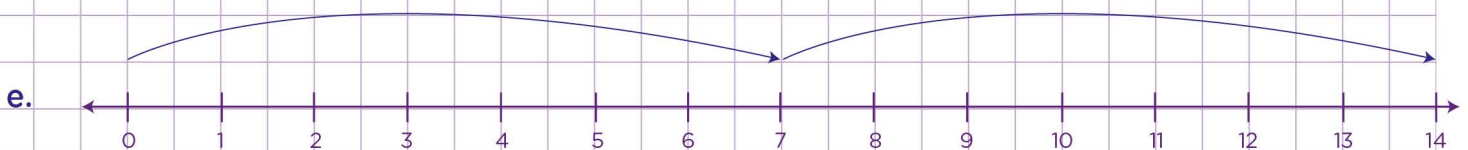

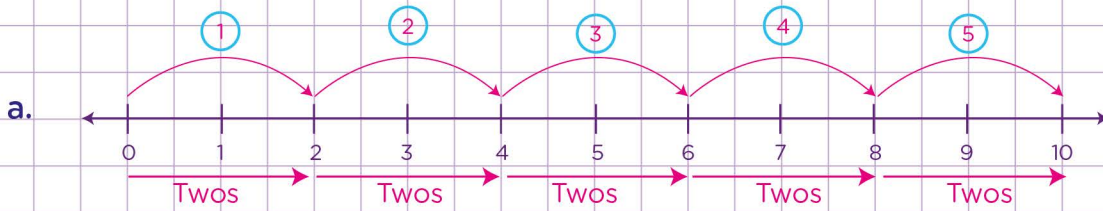

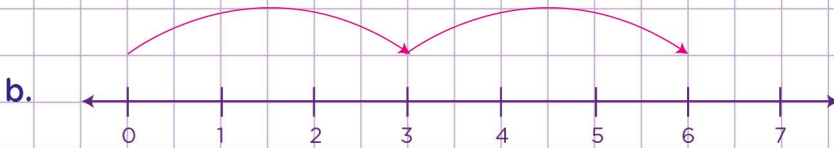
Use the number lines below to write a multiplication sentence.



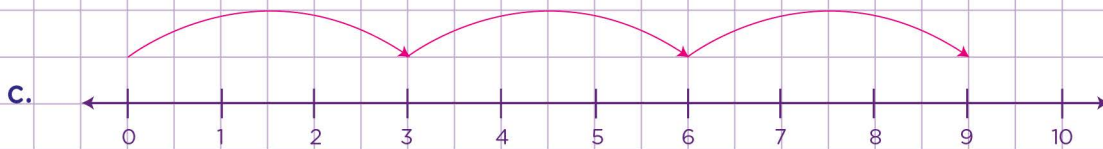
Let's interpret the number line.

You see that, on the number line we skip counted by twos 5 times and ended at 10.

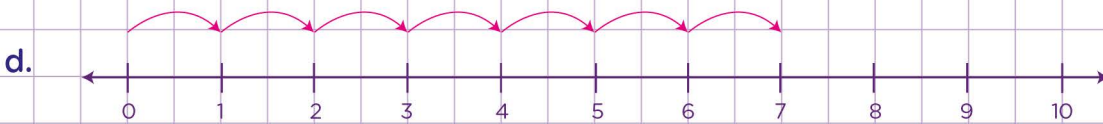
So, the multiplication sentence is $5 \times 2 = 10$.



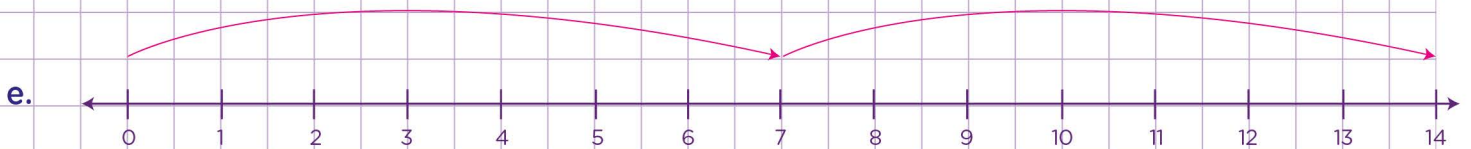
$2 \times 3 = 6$

$7 \times 1 = 7$



$2 \times 7 = 14$
