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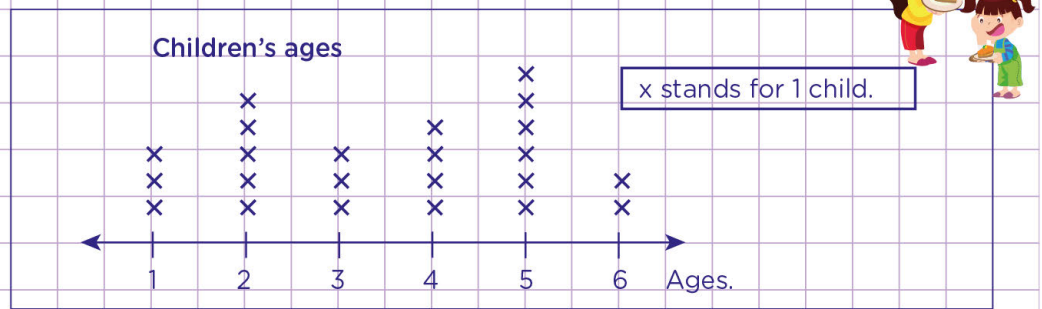
a. Mrs. Read works in an orphanage. She keeps record of the children's ages residing in the orphanage. Use the information in the table below to create a line plot.

To create a line plot, let's draw a horizontal line labelled "ages". Separate this line into equal intervals with the numbers in the first column on the table.

Then, look at the first row. Place 3x's above 1 to represent 3 children with all ages 1 year.

Do this for all the numbers in the ages' column.



b. The students in Mrs. Jonh's class compared the number of books they have read. use the information below to create a line plot.

2	2
3	7
4	9
5	3
6	1
7	11
8	12
9	4
10	6

To create a line plot, let's draw a horizontal line labelled "students". Separate this line into equal intervals with the numbers in the first column on the table.

Then, look at the first row. Place 5x's above 1 to represent the number of books read by 1 student.

Do this for all the numbers in the students' column
