Here, we are comparing two things. so we have



Small	Smaller
Vanilla cake	Red velvet cake

Also, the red velvet cake is bigger than the chocolate cake.

Here we are comparing 3 things

Small	Smaller	Smallest	Big	Bigger	Biggest
Vanilla cake	Red velvet cake	Chocolate cake	Chocolate cake	Red velvet cake	Vanilla cake

So, the red velvet cake was smaller

2. Franck and his friends, Richard, and Allen were competing on who will cover a longer distance in a race amongst them. Franck ran a shorter distance than Allen. Allen ran a shorter distance than Richard.

Who covered the longest distance and who came out last in the race?

We are comparing distance here so, we'll be dealing with short, shater shortest.

The question says that frank ran a shorter distance than Allen.

So, we have

Short	Shorter
Franck	Allen

Also Allen ran a shorter distance than richard.



Short	shorter	Shortest	Long	Longger	Longest
Frank	Allen	Richard	Richard	Allen	Frank

So, Richard covered the longest distance

Since frank ran the shortest distance, it implies that

Frank came last in the race.
