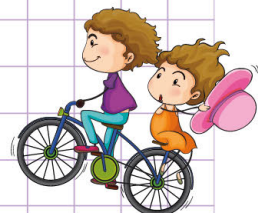

Conversion tables - customary units

a. Complete the following table.

Gallons	3	9	15	21	27	33
Quarts	12	36	60	84	108	132

We know that, 1 gallon = 4 quarts.

So, let's use this information to complete the table.

If 1 gallon = 4 quarts,

then 3 gallons = $4 \times 3 = 12$ quarts.

Therefore, to convert from gallons to quarts, multiply by 4 and to convert from quarts to gallons, divide by 4.

b. Complete the following table.

Pounds	20,000	30,000	40,000	50,000	60,000	70,000
Tons	10	15	20	25	30	35

We know that, 2000 pounds = 1 ton.

Now, to convert from pounds to tons, let's divide 2,000 and to convert from tons to pounds, let's multiply by 2,000.

c. Complete the following table.

Teaspoons	3	9	15	27	36	42
Tablespoon	1	3	5	9	12	14

The column that is complete shows that 3 teaspoons = 1 tablespoon.
