## Add and subtract fractions with unlike denominators

Add and subtract the following.

a.  $\frac{5}{6} + \frac{1}{3}$

d.  $\frac{25}{36} - \frac{12}{18}$

b.  $\frac{7}{12} + \frac{5}{6}$

e.  $\frac{1}{2} - \frac{3}{8}$

c.  $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{3}{16}$

f.  $\frac{1}{18} + \frac{1}{2}$



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## Add and subtract fractions with unlike denominators

Add and subtract the following.

a.  $\frac{5}{6} + \frac{1}{3}$  Start by finding the L.C.M

$$\frac{5}{6} + \frac{1}{3} = \frac{5 + 2}{6}$$

$$= \frac{7}{6} = 1 \frac{1}{6}$$

So,  $\frac{5}{6} + \frac{1}{3} = 1 \frac{1}{6}$

d.  $\frac{25}{36} - \frac{12}{18}$  Start by finding the L.C.M

$$\frac{25}{36} - \frac{12}{18} = \frac{25 - 24}{36}$$

$$= \frac{1}{36}$$

So,  $\frac{25}{36} - \frac{12}{18} = \frac{1}{36}$

b.  $\frac{7}{12} + \frac{5}{6}$

$$\frac{7}{12} + \frac{5}{6} = \frac{7 + 10}{12}$$

$$= \frac{17}{12} = 1 \frac{5}{12}$$

So,  $\frac{7}{12} + \frac{5}{6} = 1 \frac{5}{12}$

e.  $\frac{1}{2} - \frac{3}{8}$

$$\frac{1}{2} - \frac{3}{8} = \frac{4 - 3}{8}$$

$$= \frac{1}{8}$$

So,  $\frac{1}{2} - \frac{3}{8} = \frac{1}{8}$

c.  $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{3}{16}$

$$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{3}{16} = \frac{8 + 3}{16}$$

$$= \frac{11}{16}$$

So,  $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{3}{16} = \frac{11}{16}$

f.  $\frac{1}{18} + \frac{1}{2}$

$$\frac{1}{18} + \frac{1}{2} = \frac{1 + 9}{18}$$

$$= \frac{10}{18} = \frac{5}{9}$$

So,  $\frac{1}{18} + \frac{1}{2} = \frac{5}{9}$
